



QS Events award a generic qualification into the Cinch World Championship Junior Rodeo.

- Generic Qualifications are awarded based on the following:
 - Single round events – fastest times/highest score
 - Multiple round events fastest combined times/highest score from the overall aggregate or clean slate final round based on event format.
 - The athlete does not have to place in a paid position.

- NHSRA Western Legacy Series (WLS) QS designated events:
 - Each WLS events designated as a Qualifier Series that hosts both High School and Jr High rodeo separately:
 - High School division - the highest placing nominated Junior & Youth from each discipline will be awarded a QS spot.
 - Jr. High division - the highest placing nominated Youth from each discipline will be awarded a QS spot.
 - Badlands Challenge combined event format - the highest placing nominated Junior & Youth from each discipline will be awarded a QS spot.

- OPEN/JUNIOR QS events that combine both Leaderboards into a single event (OPEN events), will award one (1) DY23 generic qualification per Leaderboard as follows:
 - JUNIOR Leaderboard – highest placing athlete classified as a JUNIOR with the fastest time/aggregate from the nominated athletes.
 - YOUTH Leaderboard – highest placing athlete classified as a YOUTH with the fastest time/aggregate from the nominated athletes.

- YOUTH QS events will award one (1) generic qualification to the athlete with the fastest time/aggregate from the nominated athletes on the YOUTH Leaderboard.

- Multiple QS wins - If an athlete earns more than one (1) generic qualification in a discipline, the next highest placing eligible athlete that nominated an event will earn the generic qualification for that event.
 - At WLS events, the Jr High Rodeo will be used as the default event qualification and the vacated spot will be filled from the High School Rodeo.
